II. THE SPIRIT AT WORK IN THE BELIEVER

1. Conviction

(Jn 16.7-11; Acts 2.37)

What is *not* conviction?

Conviction means “to convince someone of the truth; to reprove; to accuse, refute, or cross-examine a witness.”

2. Union with Christ

(Jn 14.20; Jn 16.14)

The central role of the Spirit is to reveal Christ and to unite us to him to all those who participate in his body

1 Corinthians 12:13 “For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body – Jews or Greeks, slaves or free – all were made to drink of one Spirit.”

3. Sanctification

Sanctification means *to make holy*.

1 Cor. 6:11- And such were some of you. But you were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God.”

Galatians 5:22-23 , “The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.”

In sanctification God is at work:

2 Peter 1:3 “His divine power has granted to us all things that pertain to life and godliness.”

And, in sanctification we are at work:

2 Peter 1:5 “For this reason make every effort to supplement your faith with virtue...”

4. Intercession

Romans 8:26-27” “...the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us with groans that words cannot express...the Spirit intercedes for the saints in accordance with God’s will.”

5. Assurance

(Eph. 1:13-14, Rom. 8:9)

Romans 8:16 “The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God’s children.”
