I. What a Personal Testimony is and what it is NOT

1. A personal testimony is not the gospel.
2. A personal testimony is the story of how you came to be reconciled to God through the Gospel.
3. Sharing a personal testimony can be an effective tool in evangelism.

II. Reasons To Share Your Testimony

1. To fight fear and doubt in evangelism.
2. To encourage other Christians to share the Gospel.
3. To steer conversations with unbelievers towards the good news and bear witness to its truth in your life.

III. Tapping Our Testimonies To Point Unbelievers To Jesus

John 4:4-42

1. First, the woman testifies to others about her experience with Christ.
2. Then, she points them to Jesus.

1. What your life was like before Christ.
2. How you came to repent of your sins and believe in the gospel.
3. What your life has been like since knowing Christ.
4. How the person you're sharing with can experience the same.
