### **I. The Corporate Gathering Proclaims the Gospel**

1. When the church gathers together, non-Christians can hear the Gospel proclaimed. (1 Corinthians 14:23-25; 2 Timothy 4:1-2)
2. When the church gathers together, non-Christians can hear the Gospel prayed.
3. When the church gathers together, non-Christians can hear the Gospel in the songs we sing. (Psalm 119:172; Colossians 3:16)
4. When the church gathers together, non-Christians can see the Gospel displayed. (Matthew 28:18-20; 1 Corinthians 11:17-34)
5. When the church gathers together, non-Christians see the Gospel lived out. (John 13:34-35, 17:20-23; 1 Peter 2:12; Matthew 5:16)

## **II. Incorporating the Corporate Gathering in Evangelism**

1. When we talk about the church, we should speak highly of it.
2. We should invite non-Christians to church.
3. We should talk with our non-Christian friends about what they experienced at church.
4. We should invite non-Christians to hang out with our Christian friends.
