From a faithfully evangelistic perspective, there are two types of activities in light of the Christian world-view.

I. Those sent – the “go-ers”

A. The characteristics of a go-er.

B. They took no help from the pagans (unbelievers)

II. Those sending – support for the sake of “the Name”

B. The responsibility for staying and sending.

C. The reward for those who send.
